Reading is the key



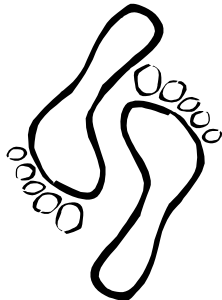
Reading is the fundamental knowledge that every task is built upon. With an ever changing society, the world has become dependent upon good readers to solve problems, perform tasks, and produce products.

One prominent criteria for third grade students is performance in Reading on the FCAT (Florida Comprehensive Achievement Test) given in March of every academic year.
