Dear Parent or Guardian:

Please read below the potential consequences for seniors committing Class III or IV offenses during the last nine week of the school year.

DCPS Policy Manual, Section JICDA; Code of Conduct, pages 13 – 22:

TITLE: Commission of Class III or IV offenses during the last nine weeks.

POLICY:

- (1) A senior student who commits a Class III or IV violation, described in the Code of Student Conduct, shall forfeit the right to participate in graduation exercises and other senior-related activities until the student has successfully completed the suspension or assignment to an alternative program and is reenrolled at the regularly assigned school. School Board policies and procedures regarding assignment to alternative centers shall apply to students who commit a Class III or Class IV violation.
- (2) Each senior high school principal shall:
 - (a) Notify all senior students and their parent of this policy during an assembly or meeting.
 - (b) Mail a notice explaining this policy to the parents or legal guardian of each senior student at the address currently shown in the official school record.
 - (c) Provide each senior student with written notification of this Policy and require the student's signature as acknowledgment of receipt.

Your son or daughter will be notified twice during the school year of the above stated rule and will sign for their copy of the rule; fist now and again in January. Seniors have been given a copy of the Student Code of Conduct. Please ask for this copy from your senior if you wish to review what constitutes a Class III or Class IV offense.
