Florida has fully adopted and will implement new standards for the 2022 -2023 school year. These standards are known as the B.E.S.T. (Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking). These B.E.S.T. were created by the teachers of Florida for the students of Florida. Academic instruction will be based upon these standards and the students will be assessed on their mastery through the new state assessment known as FAST (Florida's Assessment of Student Thinking). Highlands is ready for the work to start!


Vote: You Have A Voice!

August 23 — Voters decide whether to approve during the primary election




Extended Day???
