Our recycling focus at this time will be on recycling school paper in each classroom, collecting plastic caps from soda bottles, milk bottles, gatorade bottles, medicine bottles etc., and collecting used cell phones and accessories also for recycling. PTA is placing a labeled recycle bin for school papers, as well as bags for saving collected plastic bottle tops, in each classroom. A recycle bin will be in the front office for all donated *used* cell phones & accessories. Cell phone donations will be accepted until the end of the school year. All recyclable school papers will be added to the schools 'paper only' receptacle in the back of the school. All proceeds will go to the school. Plastic bottle caps can be sent to your child's class up until May 3rd, 2010. All proceeds from these recyclable plastic caps will go to benefit a charity chosen by one of our very own 5th graders. It was her that brought the idea of recycling plastic bottle caps to our attention. When the collection of caps ends, they will be tallied by PTA. One class in each grade level, with the highest collection of plastic caps, will be surprised with a special treat! All donated used cell phones will be sent to "Cell Phones for Soldiers", who in turn supply phone cards to our service men and woman overseas and those in transition to civilian life.
