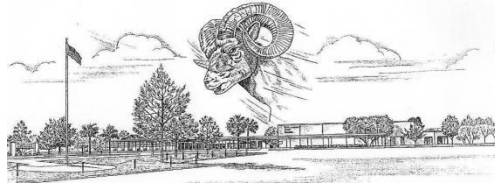

The student will have/complete/maintain:

- (1) A high school GPA of 3.0 for admission *and* for continuation at the end of the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades. INITIAL _____
- (2) An FCCJ GPA of 2.0 or better in the dual enrollment courses. INITIAL _____
- (3) An FCAT score indicating the student is 'at grade level' in reading and math (level 3 or above). INITIAL _____
- (4) An acceptable score for admission into FCCJ on the PERT, ACT or SAT exam in each subject area prior to the end of the freshman year. INITIAL _____
- (5) A portfolio of academic performance as a part of a Senior Capstone program (for high school graduation). INITIAL _____
