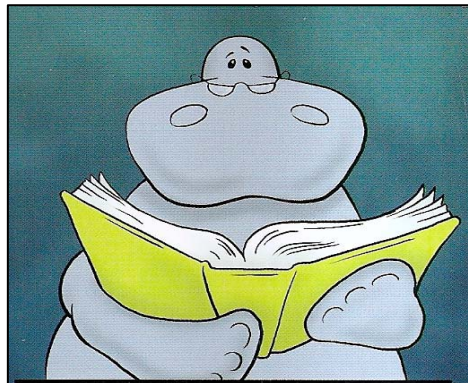

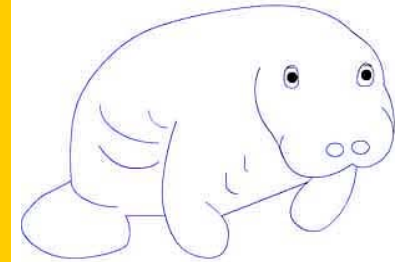

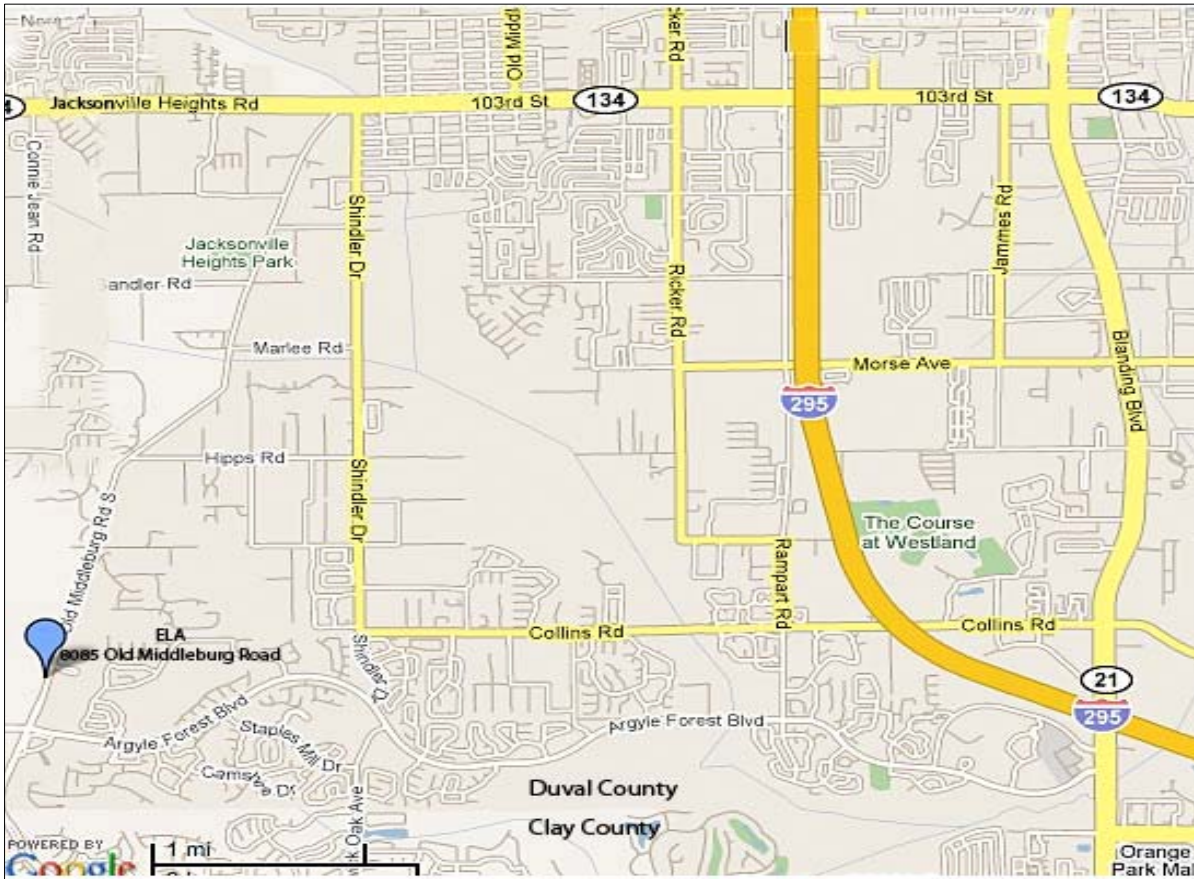

Enterprise Learning Academy opened in 1998 as school number 255 with a pre-K through fifth grade student body. We serve 800 students who arrive on foot, bike, by car and bus. Students take great pride in being "a manatee." A full service cafeteria serves 37% of the student body free or reduced price breakfast and lunch.

Parents are actively involved through a PTA and School Advisory Council, and frequent parent training workshops. Students may participate in WELA television or serve as a Student Council Officer or on Safety Patrol. Classes are offered in Art, Music, Physical Education and Media Tools.

The Florida Sunshine State Standards based curriculum, features student workshops in reading, writing, science, social studies, health and mathematics. Teachers are coached through professional development to compare student work and boost academic achievement. We are a B school under Florida's A+ system.

The student teacher ration is 18:1 in grades K-3 and 22:1 in grade four and five. We are above average on test scores and in student attendance. Our goal is to help every student achieve learning gains every year.
