Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe!

Write the grade and your child's name on the car rider sign provided with a BLACK MARKER. Please place this sign in the passenger side front window or hang from your rear view mirror with the child's name on it. **PLEASE KEEP IT THERE ALL YEAR LONG**-it helps us move faster and tells us you ARE an ELA parent. Please drive your car into the **front traffic circle in front of the school** off Old Middleburg Road. **DO NOT GET OUT OF YOUR CAR**. Students are **NOT allowed** inside the building until 8:30 am for breakfast and 8:45 am without breakfast. **NOTE** -- School Adults are on duty 8:20-9 am and 3:20-3:40 pm. **If students arrive late**, after 9 am, enter through the front door and go to class. **Extended Day** meets 7-8:20 am and 3:30-6 pm. **Daycare vans** are asked to drop off and pickup students from the bus loading area.

There is **NO** adult supervision for students at school after **3:40 PM**. Dismissal is over at **3:40 PM** from car riding zone. **If you are late picking up your child, you will need to pay for daycare in Extended Day.**

The **School Advisory Council (SAC)** is a team of people representing various segments of the community—parents, teachers, students, administrators, support staff, business/ industry people and other interested community members. The purpose of a SAC is to assist in the preparation and evaluation (developing and evaluating) of the results of the school improvement plan and to assist the principal with the annual school budget. Additionally, SAC receives funds "to be used at the discretion of the School Advisory Committee

Each school in the State of Florida must have a SAC. By law, each SAC must be composed of the principal and an "appropriately balanced" number of "stakeholders." These individuals must be representative of the ethnic, racial and economic makeup of the community served by the school.
