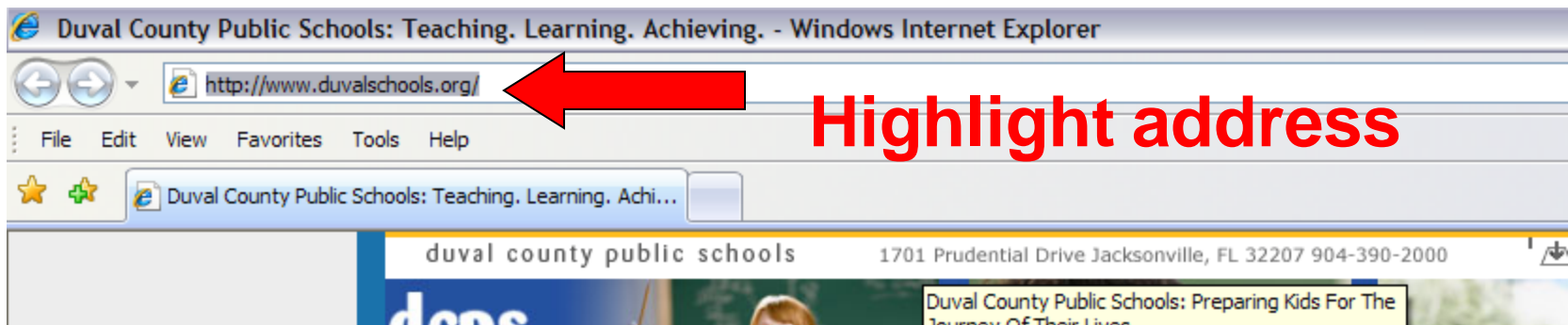
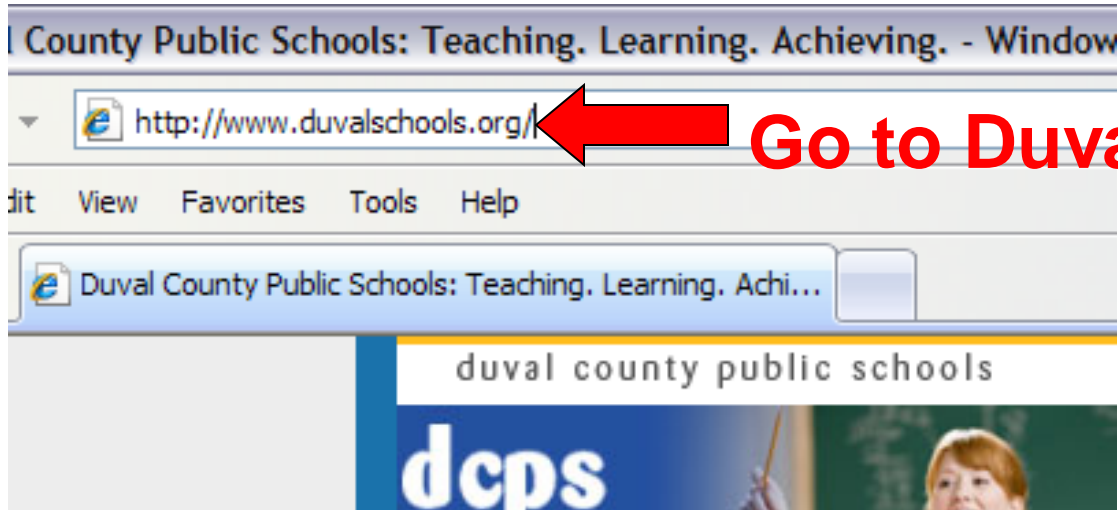

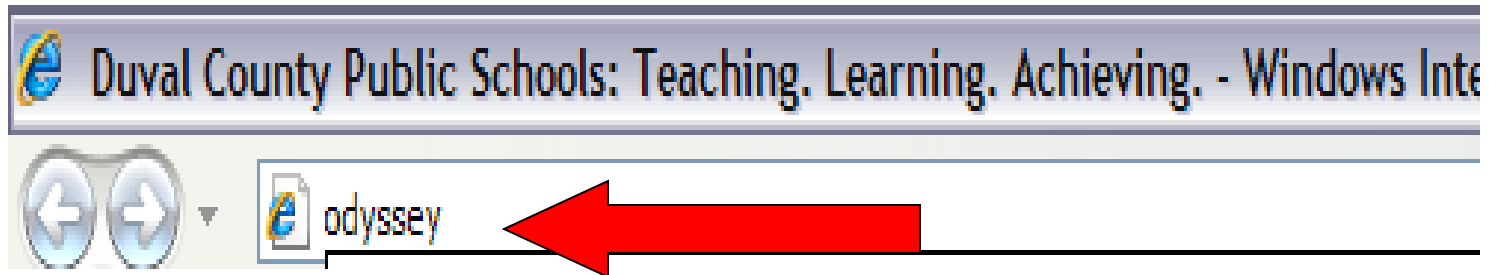
Common Mistakes

- Example: s123456677
- The **password** is uppercase of your first name, two digit day of the month you were born, lower case of your last name followed by the last four digits in your social security number.
- Example: John Doe born the 23rd of whatever month with the last four digits of social security #

Example: J23d1234


