Additional Information:

1. Any senior receiving 5 discipline referrals will lose their senior privileges, for example: Prom, Grad Bash, Senior Play Day, Prep Rally, Senior Breakfast.
2. Also, 6 tardies by any senior will result in the loss of their parking pass for 2 weeks. If it occurs again, they will lose it and be placed back on the waiting list.

NOTICE REGARDING ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS

LACKAWANNA ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM – The Lackawanna Program is a short term disciplinary program designed to serve who have violated the rules of the Code of Student Conduct. Students continue with their academic courses under an individual study plan and undergo intensive individual and group counseling in an effort to help the students improve their self-concept and modify their behavior. Students assigned there are usually first time Class III, IV and multiple Class II offenders. The program is a minimum stay of **45 days**.

GRAND PARK CAREER CENTER – The Grand Park Center is a comprehensive multifaceted program designed to serve students who may have committed multiple Class III or IV offenses or exhibited socially maladaptive behavior. The center facilitates students to become more successful in school through the imposition of disciplinary options and by using positive approaches to encourage students to change ineffective behavior patterns. This program is a minimum stay of **90 days**.
