Clinical Educator Training, CET, is required for all teachers who mentor new teachers or serve as a directing teacher for pre-service education students and interns. This in-depth two day workshop trains participants on research-based observation instruments, data analysis, and effective conferencing techniques.

Eligible teachers must have three years of successful teaching experience and the recommendation of their principal in order to attend for the training. Principals are asked to provide their approval for teachers to obtain CET in order to ensure that each new mentor has not only the knowledge and skills, but also the disposition to serve as a mentor for new and developing teachers. Participants must complete the two day training and post-test to receive their CET certificate of completion.
