**REVISIONS TO DUVAL SCHOOL BOARD POLICY ON RETENTION/PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS:**

**High School** graduation requirements were revised in April, effective beginning of the 0809 school year. Two exemptions from retention were added to the 11th grade FCAT Science requirement - an ACT science subtest score of 15; or a junior moving in from private school or out of state after the science test was given.

**Middle School** - no changes.

**Elementary School** - The required program of study for elementary students in Duval County Public Schools reflects state and local requirements for elementary education. The areas of study required for each grade, kindergarten through 5, are shown in Table 1.
