DATE: September 3, 2009

Enclosed are the results of the Senior Plans Surveys for the 2000 through 2009 school years. Each year, portions of the Senior Plans Survey results are reported in the School Public Accountability Report. Your assistance and cooperation in encouraging seniors to participate in the collection of these data elements are greatly appreciated.

Highlights of an eight-year review of Senior Plans Survey responses are provided below. Please keep in mind that some students do not respond to all survey items, and some items may generate multiple responses from a student.

- The percentage of the seniors responding to the Senior Plans Survey has remained approximately 67% from 2000 through 2008 except for the classes of 2003, 2006, 2007, and 2009. In 2003 there was an increase in responses to 70.8% and in 2009 there was a marked increase to 78%. However, in 2006 and 2007 there were sharp decreases to 51.5% and 52.4% participation rates in the survey.
- District-wide, seniors from the classes of 2000 to 2003 increasingly indicated their plans to matriculate full-time in post-secondary institutions (26.9% in 2000, 38.8% in 2001, 38.3% in 2002, and 39.6% in 2003). More than one-half of the high schools in the district showed a similar trend over the same period. On the other hand, figures from the senior classes of 2004, 2005, and 2006 indicate a decline in plans to enroll full-time in a post-secondary institution. Of the students who responded to the item on the survey, 1559 (38.1%), 1569 (36.4%), and 1544 (19.6%) respectively, confirmed intentions of full-time post-secondary enrollment. There has been a steady increase in the last 3 years 2007 (21.0%) , 2008 (25.3%), and 2009 (37.0%) in graduating classes' plans to matriculate full-time in post-secondary institutions.
- Based on their responses, beginning in 2002, Duval County high school seniors were increasingly planning to matriculate in post-secondary institutions (community colleges, technical/vocational institutes, private colleges, and state universities) in Florida. After almost doubling from 2000 to 2001, the percent of students that expressed plans to enroll in an out-of-state post-secondary institution was decreasing (6.4% in 2000, 11.1% in 2001, 9.3% in 2002, 9.4% in 2003, 8.8% in 2004, 7.8% in 2005, 4.1% in 2006, 4.5% in 2007, and 5.8% in 2008). A new trend in 2009 indicates that an increased number of students are planning to attend institutions out-of-state (15.6%).
- After graduation, seniors enter the work force for various reasons. The percent of seniors that planned to seek employment and continue their education on at least a part-time basis increased dramatically

from 2000 (30.5%) to 2001 (47.3%). Perhaps due to the recognition of the need for post-secondary preparation in almost all areas of the job market, seniors continued to express their plans to attend college and seek part-time employment. The percentages have increased, albeit in small increments from 2002 (48%) to 2003 (48.7%) to 2004 (50.1%). The percent of seniors that planned to seek employment and continue their education on at least a part-time basis decreased considerably from 2005 (48.9%) to 2006 (25.3%). The 2007 figure (25.4%) remained constant; however, there was an increase in 2008 (33.5%) and 2009 (49.1%).

- Jacksonville is clearly a military town. Many high school seniors, apparently wishing to follow in the footsteps of their parents, still look to the military as a career choice. The trend, however, is that those numbers consistently decreased after 2001 - from 4% in 2000, to 6% in 2001, to 5.2% in 2002, to 4.9% in 2003, to 4.8% in 2004, to 3.4% in 2005 to 2.1% in 2006, to 1.8% in 2007. However, there was an increase in the choice of a military career in 2008 (2.8%) and 2009 (5.7%).
- Perhaps due to some lingering indecision regarding career plans, seniors tend to select more than one career path in the surveys. That said, the top three areas of career choice for the 2000 through 2008 graduating classes have consistently been business/office, health, and public service, in that order. After the graduating class of 2003, a somewhat different selection shift occurred in their choice of career plans. The top three areas of career choices are the same, but the seniors of 2004 through 2008 seem to prefer health careers (25.9% in 2004, 23.3% in 2005, 12.3% in 2006, 12.8% in 2007, and 16.5% in 2008), followed by business/office (15.5% in 2005, 15.1% in 2005, 8.1% in 2006, 7.9% in 2007, and 9.7% in 2008), then public service (15.1% in 2004, 13.4% in 2005, 6.4% in 2006, 6.3% in 2007, and 8.6% in 2008). The seniors of 2009 prefer health careers (20.0%), followed next by public service (10.5%), then both Business/Office (4.7%) and Communications and Media (4.7%).
- Survey respondents from the class of 2000 overwhelmingly indicated that guidance counselors most often provided assistance with post-secondary school plans (73.1%). In subsequent years the responses to this item have not been as strong in any area. Generally, seniors from 2001 to 2005 seem to be of the opinion that their school guidance assistance consisted mainly of planning their high school program of study (45.4% on 2001, 45.7% in 2002, 48.4% in 2003, 43.8% in 2004, and 45.2% in 2005). There was a sharp decrease in this opinion in 2006 (22.5%); however, the opinion of their school guidance assistance has shown a favorable increase in both 2007 (24.1%), 2008 (32.6%), and 2009 (38.3%).
