Enclosed are the results of the Senior Plans Surveys for the 2000 through 2011 school years. Each year, the Senior Plans Survey results are reported to the Florida Department of Education for use in various state reporting and statistics. Your assistance and cooperation in encouraging seniors to participate in the collection of these data elements are greatly appreciated.

Several tables are attached that reflect data collected from the Senior Plans Surveys from the last twelve years. Each table displays the data collected by school. The tables attached are:

Highlights of a twelve-year review of Senior Plans Survey responses are provided below. These summarized highlights have been generated from the tables listed above. Please keep in mind that some students do not respond to all survey items, while some provide more than one response to a question. In these cases, the first answer is recorded as the student's response.

- As shown in Table A; prior to 2006, an average of 67% of seniors in the district has participated in the Senior Plans Survey. In 2006 and 2007 there were sharp decreases, 51.5% and 52.4% respectively. In 2009, 78% of seniors responded which was a drastic increase from previous years. While, 2010 showed the highest participation rate at 82.1%. This year, 77.1% of seniors responded to the survey.
- District-wide, seniors from the classes of 2000 to 2003 increasingly indicated their plans to matriculate full-time in post-secondary institutions, per Table B. More than one-half of the

high schools in the district showed a similar trend over the same period. On the other hand, figures from the senior classes of 2004, 2005, and 2006 indicated a decline in plans to enroll full-time in a post-secondary institution. Of the students who responded to the item on the survey, 1,559 (38.1%), 1,569 (36.4%), and 1,544 (19.6%) respectively, confirmed intentions of full-time post-secondary enrollment. From 2007-2010 the plans of the graduating classes to matriculate full-time in post-secondary institutions saw a steady increase [2007 (21.0%), 2008 (25.3%), 2009 (37.0%), and 2010 (37.6%)]. In 2011, this percent decreased slightly to 36.4%.

- Based on their responses shown in Table C, the percent of students who expressed plans to enroll in an out-of-state post-secondary institution double from 6.4% in 2000 to 11.1% in 2001. This trend showed a decline to 9.3% in 2002 and 9.4% in 2003. There was a five-year steady decline (from 8.8% in 2004 to 5.8% in 2008) in students indicating plans to attend college out-of-state. A new trend in 2009 (15.6%), 2010 (15.9%), and 2011 (15.2%) indicates that an increased number of students are planning to attend institutions out-of-state.
- High school graduates enter the work force for various reasons. Note in Table D, the percent of seniors that planned to seek employment and continue their education on at least a part-time basis increased dramatically from 2000 (30.5%) to 2001 (47.3%). The percentages increased in small increments from 2002 to 2004 to 50.1%. From 2005 to 2007, there was a decline by almost half to 25.4%. In 2008, an upward trend began again with 33.5% and 49.1% in 2009. For 2010 and 2011, there was a slight decrease to 46.8% and 46.5%, respectively, among seniors who plan to seek employment and continue their education.
- Jacksonville is clearly a military town. Many high school seniors, apparently wishing to follow in the footsteps of their parents, still look to the military as a career choice, as outlined in Table E. In 2011, 8.3% of seniors surveyed indicated military as a career choice, the highest ever. This could possibly be attributed to economic hardships and the fear of unemployment. This is an increase of 1.3% from 2010 and 5.5% from just three years ago in 2008 (2.8%). Prior to the increase in 2008; the military was steadily decreasing each year as a career choice.
- Perhaps due to some lingering indecision regarding career plans, seniors tend to select more than one career path in the surveys. That said, Table F shows that the top three areas of career choice for the 2000 through 2003 graduating classes have consistently been business/office, health, and public service, in that order. After the graduating class of 2003, a somewhat different selection shift occurred in the choices of career plans. The top three areas of career choices are the same, but the seniors of 2004 through 2008 seem to prefer health careers followed by business/office, and then public service. The seniors of 2009 prefer health careers (20.0%), followed next by public service (10.5%), then both business/office (4.7%) and communications and media (4.7%). Similarly, the 2010 seniors career choices were health careers (26.0%) followed by public service (13.8%), and then business/office (12.2%). This same trend continued as the 2011 seniors chose health careers (27.1%) first, followed by public service (12.5%), and then business/office (11.8%) careers. Public service, business/office, and health careers have consistently been ranked in the top three areas of career choice since 2000. Separate tables (F-1, F-2, and F-3) have been provided to show the trend in each of these three areas since 2000. Table F-4 shows the percent of seniors that have chosen other as a career choice since 2000.

- Survey respondents from the class of 2000 overwhelmingly indicated that guidance counselors most often provided assistance with high school program of study (73.1%). In subsequent years the responses to this item have not been as strong. Generally, just under half of the responding seniors from 2001 to 2005 seem to be of the opinion that their school guidance counselor assisted them with planning their high school program of study. Table G indicates a sharp decrease in the opinion of the 2006 graduates (22.5%); however, there was a favorable increase in the opinion of school guidance assistance in 2007 (24.1%), 2008 (32.6%), 2009 (38.3%) and a marked increase in 2010 (48.8%). The responses from the class of 2011 show a slight decrease to 45.9% in this opinion.
