The meetings will be every few weeks. I coach so the meeting times will vary. All meetings will be in Room 301 unless otherwise noted.

This club will not serve as a babysitting service. Therefore, the following requirements must be met and adhered to stay in the club.

- positive attitude
- willingness to learn
- good social skills
- good conduct in school

Other teachers will verify all requirements. (ABOLUTELY NO behavioral referrals will be allowed and NO OSSP for any reason – violation of these rules will result in automatic removal from the club.)

This club WILL involve handling of live animals. AT NO TIME WILL HORSEPLAY OR MISBEHAVIOR BE TOLORATED!!!! At NO time will venomous animals be brought on the school grounds. Large constrictors (over 8 ft.) will not be permitted at the meetings unless approved and supervised by Mr. Monlezun. Exposure to large and or dangerous animals is an integral part of this field, but will observed at established institutions only, such as zoos. Chance encounters are always possible when in the field, though.

Potential (optional) field trips include the Jacksonville Zoo, St. Augustine Alligator Farm, MOSH, local areas for collecting and/or photography.
