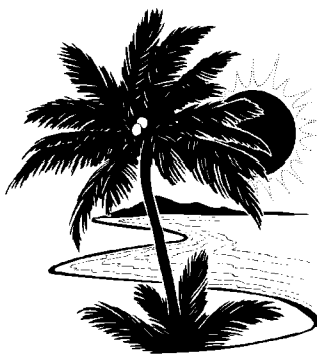

Happy Fall. I hope everyone is enjoying this refreshing time of year! I love the clean fresh air and changing of the leaves that comes with October and November.

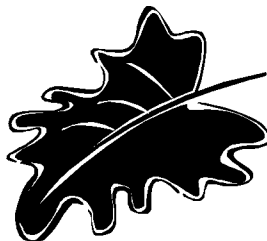
Get ready for our holiday shop from December 8 – 16, 2010. The students always love coming to shop for their parents, grandparents and siblings during this time of giving.

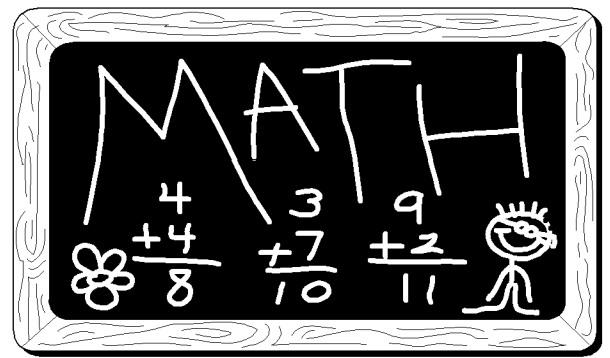
Dear Parents and Students,

December 8th - December 16th

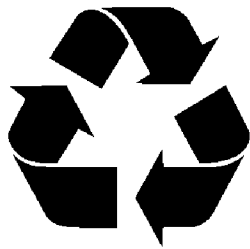
