

MyTest Hyperlink Glossary

The MyTest System has integrated links, indicated by words that are highlighted and underlined, these words that will open specific features of the program. Below is a list of definitions for each.

Benchmark Analysis	This report identifies the cognitive complexity, school average and state average based on the Sunshine State Standard.
Class Reports	A report showing a list of students to view assessment results and student profiles.
Class Results	This report shows the administered date and the number of questions students answered incorrectly. Each report is organized by student name based on an assessment.
Course Numbers	The first 7 is the state course number – The last number would be the sequence. For example, 0 would be the first semester and 2 would be the second. The missing digit that has been truncated would be the funding or level of the course. ie 1 regular ed, 6 ESOL, 5, Drop out, others are various ESE.
Item Analysis	This report captures student responses and percentage of student responses of each question from an assessment.
Logout	This link can be used to close out of the MyTest System.
My Class List	This provides a list of students per class by section number.
Profile	This section reports the demographic information for students, assessments completed, and Benchmark results.
Queued	A report or a class list is waiting to upload.
Rate this test	Rate an assessment using the following criteria: Excellent Very Good Good Fair Poor There is an error with this test. Users can rate the entire assessment or by each question from the assessment.
Report a Problem	This link allows users to report a problem with an assessment question, with answers or request training.
Review	The Review link provides an example of each question, answer and the Sunshine State Standard.
Scan Sheet	The Scan Sheet option is available for users who wish to administer the test using paper and pencil (instead of computer-based). The Scan Sheets are later scanned into MyTest system using a specified printer at the school site. Please see your school instructional coach, technology contact, or administrator for school-based instructions for using this feature.
