Welcome to the Fall edition of the Community Education Newsletter. I hope that you will find a variety of classes available for you and your family during the upcoming school year.

As you know, we faced many challenges last school year with the budget shortfall. Our School Board had to make some difficult decisions in order to have the least impact on the classroom, including the closing of a school, and changes in transportation and the secondary schedule.

We are not out of the woods yet; this budget situation is a multiple year problem. We spent a significant amount of one-time money last year, and we still face the Federal stimulus package "cliff" in two years. We will continue to be prudent in spending in order to ensure our students continue to receive a high quality education.

Our Strategic Plan was in place for the entire school year in 2008/2009 and we have continued to make progress toward becoming the best large urban school district in the nation.

We continue to make academic gains and our graduation rate has risen more than 7 percentage points in the last 10 years.

I would also like to thank those of you who are helping us reach our goal of having more volunteers and mentors in our schools. This year we had an increase of more than 1,000 mentors from 2008. We have a long way to go to reach 20,000 mentors by 2020, but with your help I know that we will get there.

I hope that each of you had a great summer! Thanks again for all that you do, and for your continued support of Duval County Public Schools.
