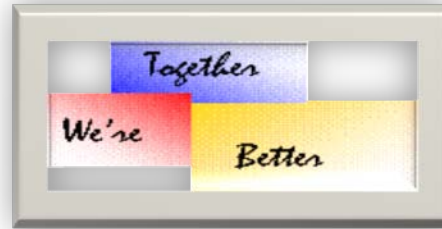

The goal of developing program standards is to identify and develop measurable levels of equity and quality of instruction throughout the district as evaluated by individual program rubrics.
