**Directions to the Schultz Center

(Located in the Midtown Office Complex)

If you are coming from the Northside:

Take I-95 South to Beach Blvd. to Boulevard Center Dr.

If you are coming from the Beach:

Take Beach Blvd. West towards Jacksonville. About 1 mile after crossing the intersection of University Blvd. look for the light at Boulevard Center Dr. and turn right onto Boulevard Center Dr.

If you are coming from the Westside:

Take I-10 to I-95 South to Beach Blvd. Follow Beach Blvd. to Boulevard Center Drive (just past Kuhn's Florist). Turn left at light on Boulevard Center Dr.

If you are coming from the Southside:

Take I-95 North to Emerson St. exit. Follow Emerson East to Beach Blvd. exit West onto Beach Blvd. Turn right at the next light onto Boulevard Center Dr.

From Boulevard Center Dr.: follow road until you see the TEAM Center directly in front of you. Turn left into the parking lot just before the TEAM Center (This is the Schultz Center parking). You will enter the Schultz Center building from the entrance located by this parking lot.

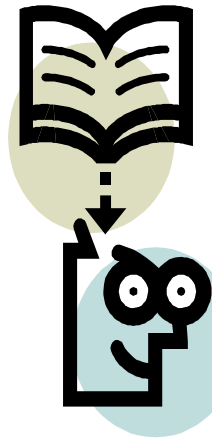


It is a **FREE** conference for families, educators and professionals.

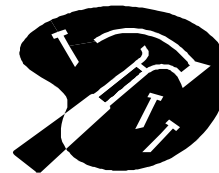
