**COMPUTER-BASED TEST ADMINISTRATIONS**

The following assessments are computer-based tests (CBT). Paper-based accommodations (Regular print and braille) will be provided for eligible students, as indicated on student IEPs or Section 504 plans. Please see the scheduling guidance below for each test.

**Grade 6 FCAT 2.0 Reading**

- Grade 6 FCAT 2.0 Reading will be administered in **two 70-minute sessions over two days**.
- Duval Grade 6 FCAT 2.0 Reading session will begin on **Day 2**.
- Sessions may be scheduled each day for the remainder of the testing window, if needed.

**Paper-based tests (accommodations only)**

- Tests should be administered on Day 2 and Day 3 of the testing window.
- As needed, make-up testing should be administered through Day 10.

**Grade 10 FCAT 2.0 Reading**

- Grade 10 FCAT 2.0 Reading will be administered in **two 70-minute sessions over two days**.
- Duval Grade 10 FCAT 2.0 Reading sessions will begin on **Day 1**.
- You may schedule sessions each day for the remainder of the testing window, if needed.

**Paper-based tests (accommodations only)**

- Tests should be administered on Day 1 and Day 2 of the testing window.
- Make-up testing should be administered through Day 5, as needed.
- All high school paper-based tests must begin administration no later than Friday, April 20, 2012.

**FCAT Mathematics and FCAT 2.0 Reading Retakes**

CBT administration window for Spring Retakes is  
**April 9 – April 13, 2012.**

**There should be no deviation from the established Duval FCAT/FCAT 2.0 administration schedule as approved by the Florida Department of Education.**
